# 3. Slave Deeds

# Documents sales of slaves, gifts of slaves, people used as collateral for loans.

# 4. Cohabitation Records

Created in 1866 to identify and legitimize marriages and children born during slavery. Also includes marriages performed in 1866-1868.

# **Historic information**

**PIN History**- History of current tax parcels – how the property has changed.

**Tax Scrolls** – produced by the Tax Collector to report the amount and type of taxes collected. **Oldest 1858. Tax Assessors Books**- lists land owner, acreage deed book/page, old ward sheet lot mapping system maps (pre- 1987). Ability to find oldest tax maps online and locate property.

# Instructions

First click on one of the following Unpaid Bills, All bills, Parcels, or Sales result sets

- Unpaid Bills Billing information, Ownership, Values, and Amounts of unpaid bills for Buncombe County.
- o All Bills Billing information, Ownership, Values, and Amounts of all bills for Buncombe County
- Parcel Parcel information, Ownership, Parcel Location, and Values of real estate parcels in Buncombe County.
- Sales Previous and new ownership, Parcel Location, Price, and Sales information on real estate sales in Buncombe County.

Second click on a selection criteria for searching from the second box. Finally, enter appropriate information before clicking the search button. Use the underlined links to display more information about a tax bill and/or transactions of a given tax bill. Any time you enter new search criteria at the top of the screen, you will begin a new search.

This tax information does not serve as a certification of taxes that are paid or currently due, and may not include additional taxes such as Discovery or Deferral bills not yet billed or which may become due.

This page is for searching current tax information.

You can also choose from options on the top black banner for ROD, GIS or PIN History.

# **PIN History**

Until 1987 tax maps were created using the Ward(township) -Sheet- Lot mapping system to identify property. The WSL system was very stable – the numbers rarely changed. The number format was XX-XXX-XXX.XX Example: 08005215.50 or ward 8 sheet 5 lot 215 and 1/5. When tax numbers were listed on the property deed it was as ward 8 sheet 5 lot 215.50.

Since 1987 tax maps are created using GIS (**G**eographic **I**nformation **S**ystem)state grid mapping system. The tax identifier is based on the center of the parcel which changes when property is sold or added or property boundaries change.

Example PIN -Parcel Identification Number 9648649940.00000 This change in mapping systems created the need for PIN History.




The first screen shows historic deed data, acreage, ownership, etc. PIN History search screen – search options to view the following help sheet click on Need Help? At top left corner

**Pin History** can be used to find the deed book/page etc. and the old tax ID number which can then be used to find the oldest tax records.



**Tax Scrolls** – produced by the Tax Collector to report the amount and type of taxes collected. **Oldest records 1858.** 


**To Access historic information, choose Tax Department** from top banner on the first page. Scroll down to "Tax Department Quick Links".



**Choose "Land Records"** Then choose "Public Records"



You can access the records from the drop down or from the Quick links on the left.




Tax Assessors Books- lists land owner, acreage deed book/page, old ward sheet lot mapping system maps (pre 1987). These tax ID numbers do not change.


Ability to find oldest tax maps online and locate property

.Some old deeds have Ward Sheet Lot number as description of property.

Example

- 1. Go to https://www.buncombecounty.org/governing/depts/tax/
- 2. Scroll own and choose "Land Records"
- 3. Scroll down and choose "Public Records"
- 4. Choose from dropdown options: Assessor's Books" or "Tax Scrolls" etc.
- 5. Tax Assessors Books, submit, accept
- 6. Search by old Ward/Sheet/Lot map number
- 7. Options look at individual lots or map by choosing "View"





This is ward 6 sheet 4 lot 350 – Assessor Book Entry


Close window and view additional information or search again to look at another ward/sheet.

	de every effort to make the tax scrolls available to the public, however, some may be of poor quality or unavailable due to conversion from microfilm. Some contain multiple years. These will be shown as "cross referenced" which will require additional searches. The year to search by is provided in the cross cords.
Tax Scrolls a	are listed in the name of the owner as of January 1 of the tax year.
Current year	tax scrolls will be made available after December 1st.



Choose "View" to see the copy of the microfilm of 1858 Tax Scroll.



The word "poll" is an archaic term for "head" or "top of the head". "AKA "head count". In 1858 in NC Head of household paid a head tax on all men 21-44 and slaves 12-49, Women were not taxed.
