Buncombe County Census Records 1790-1840 with Consolidated Index. by Henry & Christine McNab. (2015) There was no 1790 census for Buncombe County, but this book presents the data for the sections of Burke and Rutherford Counties that became part of Buncombe. Each census year contains a transcription of the original record, including the name of the head of family, and the ages of the members of the family as well as a column for slaves. There is an alphabetical index for each census year included at the back of the section. The last section of the book includes a consolidated index of all the heads of household listed in all the censuses from 1790 -1840.
