She remembered the first car in Marshall and witnessed the 1916 flood. In fact, her Dad and Aunt were the only two fatalities in the flood there. The book follows Nora's life as she married in Michigan and raised three daughters while adapting to life changes and dying at 98 years old. The story is told in Nora's own voice by her daughter based on the stories she hears from her Mom over the

years. Local families include Guthrie, Briggs, Ball, Candler, and Crane. **NEWER BOOK! *Cemeteries in Little River Township***, by Transylvania County Cemetery Board of Trustees. Little River was one of the earliest communities in Transylvania County, NC. This book documents 11 Cemeteries found in this community. You may think this information is on the Internet, but this book goes beyond that. There is a history of Little River including what happened when electricity came to the area & the damming of Little River that created Cascade Lake. Each cemetery has a little background/history & pictures of people and markers. They have gone further to document notes about the burials and about unmarked burials in some cemeteries. Smith, (2024) There were two regiments of the Federal Army raised in the mountains of western North Carolina and Tennessee in 1863. This book focuses on the Second NC Mounted Infantry but also includes documentation for the 3rd NC Mounted Infantry due to their entanglement in history. Smith was driven by a desire to tell the truth about these regiments and the men who served in them. Not only does he tell the regiments history, he also provides details about the men who served. **NEWER BOOK! *When Violence Came to the Mountains, History of The Third North Carolina Mounted Infantry, June 1864-August 1865***, by David P. Smith (2024)

This is the second book by David Smith on the two Federal Army regiments raised in the mountains of WNC. David describes the impact on WNC by the 3rd NCMI, under the leadership of George Washington Kirk. He states that he focused on separating fact from fiction. He identified the men involved, where were they from and what were they like. "I had to stay to the facts that I could find and if it was a well-known event, but not supported by facts, then I left it out, rather than embellish something I could not prove." When Doug passed away, they were working on this branch of the Barringer family. Larry has finished the book and divided it into two volumes. This first volume focusses on the Barringer/Chariker family relationships. They trace the family from Germany in the 1600's to North Carolina and points west. **NEWER BOOK! *A Heritage Revealed, The Early Biddick Family of Southwest England –***

***Second Edition***, by Randy Biddix. (2025) The author has written this book as a follow up to *Legacy that Endures: The Story of my Biddix Ancestors of Western North Carolina* which tells the story of his 5<sup>th</sup> great grandfather, John Bittick, who came to America from the British Isles sometime before 1753. This second book expands on the earlier research by tracing the origins of the family back to England. A number of records which explore the surname and its usage, locations and movements, occupations, and the likely progenitor of the family back to the 12<sup>th</sup> Century are presented. A detailed review of the parish records and a Y-DNA analysis are also highlighted. Original research for this book was conducted in England by the author. There are 114 pages including a number of pictures, maps, graphics, and documents. **This second edition is the result of further research by the author. **NEWER BOOK! Chastain – Elijah Chastain of Caney Fork, Haywood County, North Carolina**, by Wes Patterson (2024) This is the second volume of “Butterfly Biographies,” a series of books on the author’s ancestors. Elijah Chastain was the great-grandson of French Huguenot Dr. Pierre Chastain, the original Chastain immigrant. Wes Patterson is Elijah’s 4<sup>th</sup> great Grandson. Elijay was married three times and the father of at least 23 children. His three wives were Hannah Adams, Anna Middleton and Catherine Carson. The book is well sourced and includes maps, pictures and QR codes making it possible to visit many locations. A few of the other surnames in the book are Patterson, Denton, Kincaids, Cowards, Carson, Middleton, Nicholson, and Akins. Green (1995) *Back in Print!* Virginia Green produced this book back in 1995 as she researched the Clayton line for joining the DAR. She accumulated so many documents on George Clayton she decided to preserve that research in this two-part book. Part One covers the first eight generations and Part Two covers generations 9-12. **NEWER BOOK! The Coleman Family of 36 Montford Avenue, Asheville, North Carolina**, by Jane Zimmermann Slaton & Sandra Samz, (2024) The Coleman family lived in the historic district of Montford in Asheville, NC from the late 1800s to the mid-1900s. Their home was at the entrance to Montford Ave. and was sometimes referred to as a “castle.” This book shares their story through personal family letters, but names of other Asheville residents are mentioned in the letters. We also have a glimpse of life in Asheville during this time – the paving of streets, the flu epidemic, the celebration of the end of WWI. The family story is combined with the story of the home and its fate. It reads like a novel, but it is not fiction. Sb, 144 pgs, illustrated and full name index. **REPUBLISHED! Henry – Fear in North Carolina = The Civil War Journals and Letters of the Henry Family.** Compiled and Edited by Karen L. Clinard and Richard Russell (2008) Reprinted by OBCGS (2024) Fear in North Carolina compiles Comelia Henry’s three journals, written between 1861 and 1868, into a single volume, supplemented with additional family letters, documents and photos. Newspaper advertisements and period photos provide historical perspective. The journals provide an excellent source of information on Western North Carolina prior to, during and following the Civil War. Her writings express her thoughts and fears as she describes her daily routines, rumors and news of the war, raids, and occupation of Asheville by Union troops, and finally, troublesome times after the war. Also provides genealogical information for families living in the Sulphur Springs/West Asheville area during that time, information not available in typical genealogical sources. 442 pages, sb, Illustrated, full index. Perhaps the book is best described by Jerry VeHaun, former Mayor & former Buncombe County EMS Director – the stories “offer a glimpse into the heart and soul of the local area’s history along with never-before-revealed insight into the person who informed newspapers regularly.” 216 pages, soft bound. By 1798 they were in Buncombe County. Their neighbors there and in Haywood County include many well-known WNC families. The family migrated to Union County, GA and that is where John died. There are many images including maps identifying the location of the Patterson family. Wes also provides QR codes that allow you to "visit" many locations in person. 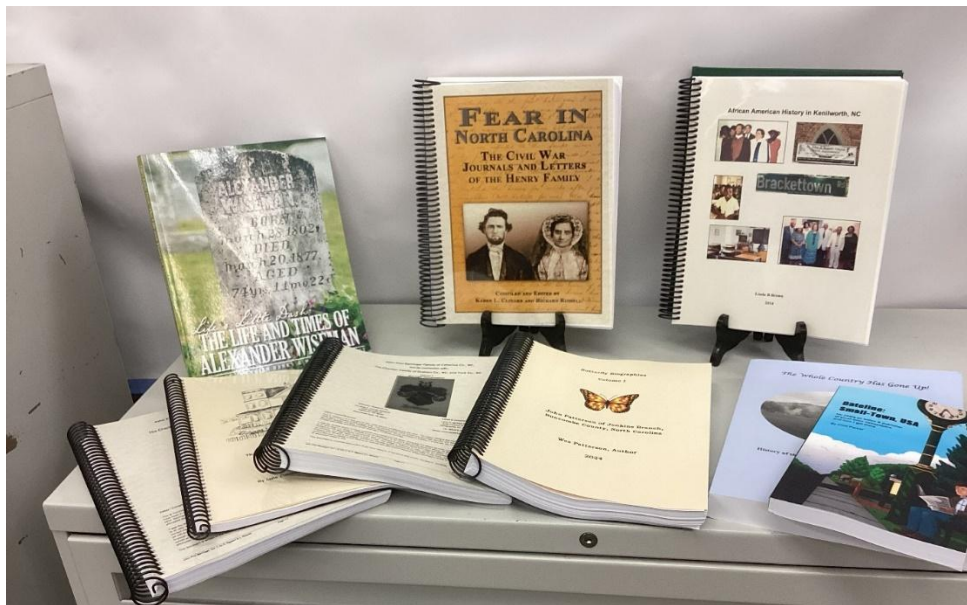
